It was good to see all the children back in school last week and fully immersed in their learning once again. They are enjoying their new themes for the term.

By the time you receive this newsletter, you should have also received a copy of the overview of learning for your child's class for this term. This will show you what is being covered in school and how we will go about instilling our three curriculum drivers—Diversity, Initiative and Possibilities, across all areas of learning. We hope that by having this information, you will be able to continue to support the learning at home and have conversations with the children around their experiences in school.

With the recent change in temperature in mind, please ensure that all children are coming to school with a coat. We are also able to order fleeces which the children can wear in class—for more information about this please contact the school office.

It was noticeable last week, particularly in Challenger class, that a number of children are failing to bring in their PE kit. There are PE lessons every Thursday, but ideally a PE kit should be in school every day to allow for flexibility in the timetable. Last year, all children were provided with a new Team PE T-Shirt. Please can all parents remind the children to bring their kits into school. Thank you for your support with this.

This Friday is the first of our class assemblies for the school year. We welcome all parents of children in Voyager class to come along to the school hall at 9am. Following the assembly, parents are then invited back into the classroom to sit with the children and their books and talk to them about their learning. If your child uses an inhaler for asthma please can you ensure that this is in school. Please bring this into the school office in the original packaging and complete the necessary paper work. If you are unsure if the inhaler is already in school or not please contact the office.

In the interests of children's safety, please can we ensure that at the end of the school day all families are leaving the school via the path and not the driveway. To ensure this is possible, it would help if parents did not wait on the driveway. Thank you for your support in this matter.

We have just received our new school football kit which is sponsored by Tilmanstone Salads. We are extremely grateful for their support in helping us get this. Our first outing in the new football kit will be on Friday 16th November, when a team of Year 3 and 4 children take part in a RAiD Football Tournament at Dover Leisure Centre.
