A massive thank you to all who donated food to our Harvest Festival last Friday. It was great to see so many parents in attendance at the assembly. We are now in the process of handing the donations over to provide support to some of the elderly in our community.

Tomorrow (Tuesday 9th October) at 2:30pm we welcome parents with children in Discovery class to come in and read with your child. This will be a great chance for parents to see the children in their new school environment. If you are unable to make this event, but would still like the opportunity to come in and read with your child, please speak with Miss McGregor.

Last Friday after-school, we held the PTA Bingo in the school hall. Thank you to those who came along—it was a fun event which raised over £50 towards the school PTA.
