Over the course of the next three weeks class teachers are putting on parental workshops in reading, writing and maths. The purpose of these is to provide parents with additional information, understanding and resources to continue to provide support to children from home as well as at school. This week's workshops are on Reading before moving onto Writing next week and then finally Maths following that. All sessions start at 2.45 pm and will last around 15 minutes to allow you to be back on the playground to collect children as normal. Days for year groups are as follows:

Tonight, some of our children and their families have signed up to attend the Stories Around The Campfire event. We hope this is a fun night for all. For all those who are coming along, please make your way across the KS2 playground, down the path next to Tots Nursery and over towards the Forest School area. A member of staff will be there to register you and point you in the direction of some hot refreshments. We have had a number of 100 word story entries from children of all ages and look forward to hearing these read out.

Thank you to those parents who came to attend Atlantis class assembly on Friday. The children produced a very thoughtful and emotive assembly based around remembrance and a 2 minute silence was wonderfully observed by all.

Last Friday was also the first Forest School sessions of the term led by Mrs Wilkinson-Tough. This was the first opportunity of the year for Years 4,5 and 6 to engage in these sessions. The feedback from all parties was extremely positive and the children certainly seem to be revelling in this new opportunity.

This Friday (17th November) some of our Year 4 pupils will take part in a RAID football tournament at Dover Leisure Centre. Letters regarding this have already gone home to the selected children. This will be the first sporting event for many of the boys involved and I am sure it is one they will remember.

I can confirm that this event will actually last the entire morning and so will run from 9am until just before Middy. We look forward to seeing many of you there. Additionally, on the same day (Friday 1 December) our Christmas Fayre takes place in the hall straight after school.
