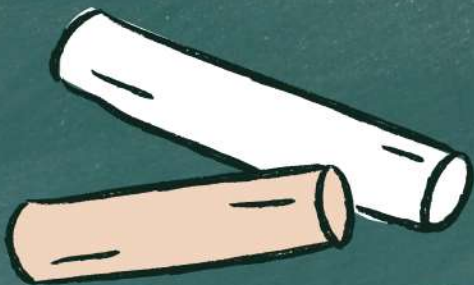


School Newsletter
