

Eythorne Elvington CP School





Next Thursday (21st October), just before the end of term, I would like to invite parents into school to allow the opportunity for your children to show you their books and talk about their learning this term. Please note, this is not a session in the form of a Parent/Teacher meeting, however simply a chance for you to look through your child's books and also to look at the changes we have made to our learning environment. To be as flexible as possible with timings to ensure everyone has the opportunity to come in, school will be open from 3:15pm until 7pm. A separate letter with finer details on arrangements for this Open Evening will be sent home early next week.

Parent/Teacher Consultations

As I pointed out in last week's newsletters, the first round of parent/teacher meetings will take place later in term two. The prime reason for this is to allow us to have a complete accurate assessment of where children are and more importantly what we all need to work on over the course of the remaining two thirds of the school year.

With this in mind, this does not mean that teachers are not able to or willing to speak with parents any ANY TIME should you have any questions/queries regarding your child in any way. I would ask parents to not wait until parent/teacher meetings take place should you have any concerns or questions in the meantime. Teachers are often available at the end of the school day or failing that appointments can be made to see them via the school office – the same applies should you wish to talk anything through with myself individually.

Open Days

For those with children who will be starting school in September 2022 it would be great to meet with you and show you around the school. Even if you have always had children here in the past, the school has changed a lot over the last 12-18 months or so and it would be great to show this to our families. There is no better time to see a school than during the school day when everything is in full flow. We do not set specific open day times here, we much prefer it if parents arrange a time to come and see us on a day at time that works for them. It has been lovely to meet new families from the area this week and show them around our school as they consider which school is best for their child come next September. Please contact the school office should you wish to have a viewing of school in the coming weeks/months prior to applications having to be completed by January.
