Welcome back to another new term at school. We hope that all families had a fun and relaxing break over the Easter period.

Although it seems like a long time ago now, thank you to the parents of children in Discovery class who came in for their class assembly during the last week of term.

We had a great turnout for the annual Easter Egg Hunt which raised just over £100 for the PTA.

During the last week of term, all pupils received a talk from a member of the local fire service with information around remaining safe when dealing with fire. We are sure they have come home and shared this information with you.

The children in Endeavour class had the opportunity to visit the Roman Painted House in Dover on the last Tuesday of term. This was a fantastic experience for them and one that we would recommend for families as a local attraction.

We are now into the last two terms of this academic year. We have one parent/teacher consultation date to come but in the meantime if you have any queries about your child's development or how to support them further at home please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher.

Forest School sessions for this term will be for the children in Years 1,2 and 3. These will take place fortnightly with effect from Friday 27th April. Please ensure that all children continue to bring additional clothing with them to school. Even though we will hopefully be receiving warmer weather, the area can be largely shaded and warmer clothes will still be needed. On Friday 4th May is Family Sports Night. A separate letter regarding this will be coming home shortly. This event will run between 5-7pm to allow for as many parents as possible to attend. The night will consist of a range of sporting activities for you to take part in both alongside and in competition with your child.

A reminder later on this term that we do have a public bank holiday when the school will be closed (Monday 7th May).

This term the pupils in Year 6 will sit their national end of Key Stage assessments (SATS). These take place during the week of 14th—18th May. It is imperative that all children are in school during these dates. For information about the plans for this week will be coming home to parents of children involved in the next week.

As the warmer weather is welcomed by us all it will also provide us with the opportunity to take part in my sporting events both in school and across the district. The first of these takes place in the last week of term when a team of children from Endeavour class will take part in a Cricket tournament with teams from Sibertswold, St Martins and Priory Field schools. A separate letter will come home to the parents of the children selected for this in due course.
