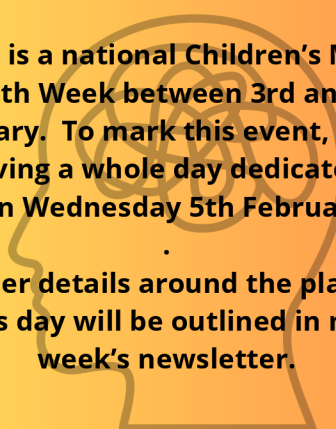

Children's Mental Health Week

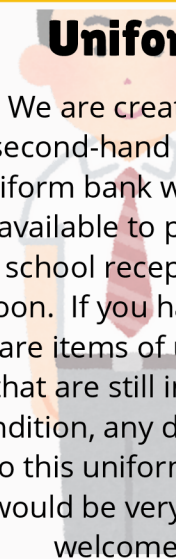
There is a national Children's Mental Health Week between 3rd and 7th February. To mark this event, we will be having a whole day dedicated to it on Wednesday 5th February

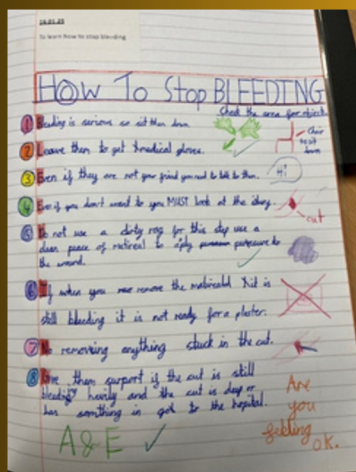
Attendance This Week
