It was great to hear from a number of children today of the fun that was had by many of the pupils and their families at Dover Athletics Family Day on Friday. Those who submitted a piece of Family Learning Homework last week were rewarded with tickets to Saturday's game. Also, last week some of the remaining tickets were sent them home with children who we felt were making a superb effort with their work. As well as having a great time, they also got to see Dover win 1-0! If any parents have photos of the day they are willing to share with school then please let us know. We have sets of tickets for two future fixtures throughout the school year so look out for news of these in a newsletter.

A reminder that this Friday the school will celebrate the Harvest Festival. All parents are invited to come along to this special assembly at 9am on Friday 6 October in the school hall. The theme is "Harvest Around The World" and each class will present something around this theme. On Friday, please can children or parents bring to school some food to add to our collection. All of these donations will go to a valuable local cause.

Also on Friday, after school, we are hosting a Bingo Evening. This will take place in the school hall immediately after school (3.15pm) and will go on until no later than 5pm. Children are welcome to attend with their family members. The cost of this is £2.00 per adult and £1.00 per child. There are cash prizes available as well as refreshments for sale. We hope to see as many families there as possible. All proceeds go to supporting the very important school PTA. On a Wednesday afternoon you may have noticed that children take part in tennis lessons on the Key Stage Two playground in the afternoon. Last Monday we introduced a playleader scheme at break and lunch times. The format of this is that 3 or 4 children from years 5 or 6 spend time on the Key Stage One playground creating games for the younger pupils of the school. So far, the feedback from all parties has been really positive. Initiatives such as this give the older students a sense of responsibility and draw on skills not always seen in school.
