Welcome back to a new school year. We hope that you enjoyed the summer break. It was great to see all the children returning to school this morning full of excitement and enthusiasm. It was also lovely to see our new pupils arriving for their first day in Discovery class – we look forward to getting to know them much more of the coming weeks.

You will have noticed there have been adjustments made to the building to accommodate one of our new pupils this year. We have reminded the children in assembly this morning to be mindful of these changes and ensure they are sensibly behaved around them – particularly the new ramps. We ask that you reiterate this message to your children also please. Thank you.

Starting a new school year can be daunting for many pupils let along those that may be starting at Eythorne Elvington for the very first time. If you wish to talk to a member of staff we are always visible on the playground at the end of the school day or you can call around to the classroom before morning registration.

We like to hit the ground running at the start of a new year and so all areas of the curriculum will be on the timetable immediately. With this in mind, please ensure that children have a full PE kit with them in school. Ideally, this will be in school every day so that if needed – depending on the weather – adjustments to when PE is taught can be made. All children should have a House PE T-Shirt as part of their kit. For those starting in EYFS today, please contact the office about these.

It is important that children bring water bottles into school on a daily basis. We ask that only water is contained in these bottles. If for any medical reason this needs discussing please contact the class teacher. Next week, the teachers will be hosting "Meet the Teacher" sessions. The idea behind these is to allow you the chance to ask any questions around what is going to be happening between now and July 2020 for your child. It is also a good time for teachers to outline their expectations of the children and explain ways we can work together between school and home to get the most out of your child.

Coming home later on this week will be a termly overview. These are particular to each class and explain all the areas of learning being covered within the first term. It will also incorporate how our three core drivers for the school – Diversity, Initiative and Possibilities – are to be interwoven throughout the teaching and learning. You will also be provided with some "Home Learning" opportunities to carry out with your child to continue their development away from school. Should you need any further explanation on these or support with them, please speak with your child's class teacher.

A reminder, at the end of the school day, children from Discovery and Voyager class should be collected by an adult from the infant playground.

For those children in Years 3 to 6 – they should be collected from the junior playground.

Information about clubs for Term One will be coming home this week – these will start as always in the second week of term (week commencing Monday 9th September) and will run until the second to last week of term (week commencing Monday 7th October). Clubs will last for two terms this year so as to allow children to become fully immersed in the activity that they choose.
