The first week back following the February half term was as busy as ever and it was good to see the children straight back into some fantastic learning across all classrooms.

Our Monday assembly last week was a visit from NSPCC who spoke to all children at some point during the morning. You should have received a letter home all about this and about the fact that today the children are taking part in a charity Dance-a-thon! We have selected a piece of music and whenever the children hear that music played in school, they must stop what they are doing and dance! This is a fundraising event for the NSPCC and we ask that all children bring in £1 to donate towards this important cause.

This coming Thursday is **World Book Day**. Children are invited to come to school dressed as their favourite book character. As part of their daily timetable, the children will take part in some classroom activities around this.

Coming home this week is the latest **Scholastic Book Club** catalogue. Any orders for books through this method need to be back in school by Friday 16th March. There is an offer for you to save £1 on any purchases using the World Book Day token. These tokens will be kept in school this week and can be collected at any point. Each child is able to have one token. These tokens can also be used in local book stores.

Forest school sessions for years 4, 5 and 6 start up again this Friday. With the potentially cold weather that is forecast, please ensure that all children bring plenty of additional warm clothing to wear whilst outside during these sessions. As always, we can provide them with additional water proofs.

This coming Friday is our **PTA Disco** evening. The cost for this is £3 per child and this includes a hot dog, pudding and a drink. Should you wish for your child to attend please ensure money is in school by the end of Wednesday. Children should bring clothes into school which they will change into at the end of the school day. All children should be collected by an adult from the school hall at 5pm. We currently have a number of leaflets in school for a new local charity called **Dads House**. This is a charity looking to provide support for Dads in a range of methods. For more information on this please collect a leaflet from the school office. As we previously mentioned, we are forecast some **cold weather conditions** during the course of this week. Please ensure that children are coming to school with appropriate clothing for this. Regardless of the weather, the school will still remain open and parents should call us should they have any concerns regarding this.
