Assembly

This morning Jenny Groombridge delivered an assembly to the children to mark the Holocaust Memorial Day. Jenny carries out two to three assemblies a term, mostly on Tuesday mornings, and we are grateful for her contribution in this way to the school.

Reading



A reminder that all children are working on a whole-school reading challenge. We expect all pupils to be reading at home at least five times a week. Ideally, they would also be having the opportunity to read to someone – a parent, grand-parent or sibling. The children have been told that it does not just have to be books that they are reading. They may wish to read a newspaper, magazine or a comic for example. We ask that an adult at home marks their reading record to indicate that reading has taken place at home. Thank you in advance for your support in this matter.

Educational Visits

We have a couple of educational visits on the horizon. Next Monday (4th February) Discovery class are visiting Wingham Wildlife Park to find out all about the animals and their habitats. On Monday 4th March, Atlantis class are visiting Dover Museum to take part in a range of workshops linked to their current theme of Ancient Egypt. Parents of children involved in these educational visits will have already received a separate letter containing more information and a permission slip. If you have yet to see this please contact the school office for a copy.

Child Safety

There are still a number of families who are choosing to use the driveway to leave the school at the end of the school day. We are telling the children during our assemblies to make sure they use the path to ensure we protect their safety; please support us in this matter by encouraging this also.

Parent/Teacher Consultations
