Welcome back to the second term of this school year, we hope that all families enjoyed their week-long break.

Thank you to everyone who came along to our Lantern Walk before the half term break. It was great to see so many families have the chance to see a small taste of what happens in our Forest School area. Mrs Wilkinson-Tough will continue to take these Forest School Sessions every Thursday. Please ensure that children bring in additional warm clothing for their allocated days. It is also important that they have suitable footwear, ideally wellington boots or walking boots.

Following our Parents Evening consultations at the end of last term, a number of parents indicated they would benefit from more information about the teaching of phonics so that they can continue the support at home. We are more than happy to help with this and so Mrs Sutcliffe will be holding a Phonics Workshop. Year 1 is on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> November and Year R on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> December – both sessions start at 2.30pm.

A key date on the horizon is our opening evening for parents looking to enrol their children into Reception class in September 2020. We look forward to meeting many current and new parents at this event which takes place at 6pm on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> November. If you are unable to make this date and time but still wish to have a look around the school then please contact the school office to arrange a more suitable time.

A reminder to all parents with children in Year 6, this Thursday (31<sup>st</sup> October) is the deadline for application for Secondary School. If you need any support with the application process please ensure that you contact the school office ASAP.
