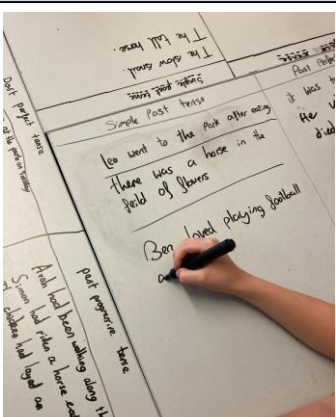
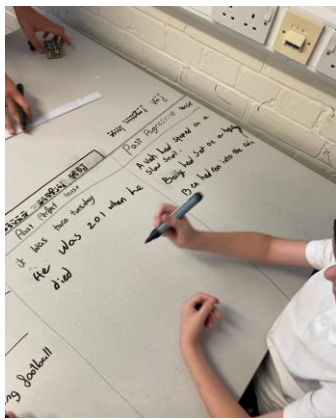


## Non-uniform dates for Summer Fayre Tombola
