This Friday (4th May) is our Family Sports Night. You should have received a letter home on Friday with more details about this. The event will run from 5-7pm and all families are invited to come along and take part in sporting activities both with and against their child.

There is no cost for this event, however, refreshments will be available to buy on the night. To register a place for this, please complete the permission slip and return to school by Wednesday indicating the number of adults and children that will be attending.

Last Friday, the children in Year2 visited Dover castle as part of their Castles topic. Thank you to Miss McGregor for arranging this fantastic trip for the children. We look forward to hearing all about this educational visit in the weeks ahead.

Sports Day has now been confirmed as taking place on the morning of Wednesday 18th July this year. In the event of poor weather like last year, this will still allow us the possibility of rescheduling it before the end of the school year. Further details about the Sports Day will come home closer to the time.

Another date we can confirm is the end of year production. This will take place on Friday 20th July and will involve all of the children from Endeavour class. Further arrangements will be communicated with parents later on in the term.

With sports day not too far away, this would be a good opportunity for parents to buy PE House T-Shirts for their children. These should then be worn in all PE lessons. To see the T-Shirts and try different sizes please call into the office. These will be at a cost of £6 each.

As this academic year continues to speed by we are now looking ahead to 2018/19. On the afternoon of Thursday 24th May we will be welcoming all parents of children who start in Reception class in September.

This meeting will give you all the information needed before the summer including key “transition” days for the children to come into school. If you are unable to make this date please contact the school to arrange a more convenient time.
