Thank you to those parents who came along last Friday for Endeavour class assembly. The children clearly enjoyed their part in this event and showed great confidence throughout. It was good to see some parents staying behind afterwards to take part in a fun learning activity. This Friday we welcome the parents of those children in Atlantis class.

On Friday, the children should have come home with a letter about the curriculum here at Eythorne Elvington. There are a number of parent workshops coming up (dates are listed on the reverse of this newsletter) and these are a good opportunity for you to find ways to further support your children at home with their learning. You will have also noticed a number of events we are putting on as a school throughout the year to allow families the time to enjoy some exciting activities linked to our curriculum. We have tried to make these times as suitable to all as possible. One date to notice there has been a slight change is—Stories Around The Campfire will now take place on Monday 13th November at 5.30pm. More information about this will be coming to you in a separate letter this week.

We have tried to provide you now with as many dates as possible right across the school year calendar. As I am sure you can appreciate there are times when these may have to change—on these occasions we endeavour to let you know with as much notice as possible. As you can imagine, this term in the run up to Christmas is one of the busiest so please check these dates to ensure you do not miss out on anything. In the meantime, any questions about this please do contact the school office.

School clubs start again from today. Once again thank you to all adults that give up their time to provide these extra curricular activities for the children. In the main all clubs will always start on the second week of every term and will finish on the penultimate week of term. Those wishing to have a place at an after school club will have completed a permission form which contains all dates. Children wishing to attend lunch time clubs will need to speak with their class teacher. As the nights are getting darker please make sure all children are collected by an adult from after-school clubs at 4pm.

Last week, you may have noticed on the playground examples of the fantastic new house PE shirts available to order. We are able to provide these at a cost of £5.95. They are to be worn for all PE lessons, House events and Sports Day. Should you wish to place an order then please contact the school office.

Please keep in mind there are three Fridays coming up where we are asking the children to come into school in non-uniform as part of our aim at raising products for the Tombola at the Christmas Fayre. The dates for these are on the back of the newsletter.

A reminder for those parents with children looking to start school in September 2018, that at 6pm on Tuesday 21 November we are holding a meeting for you to come along and find out more about us and for you to ask any questions you may have about the school or the process itself. In the meantime, should you wish to come for a look around the school, you are always more than welcome!
