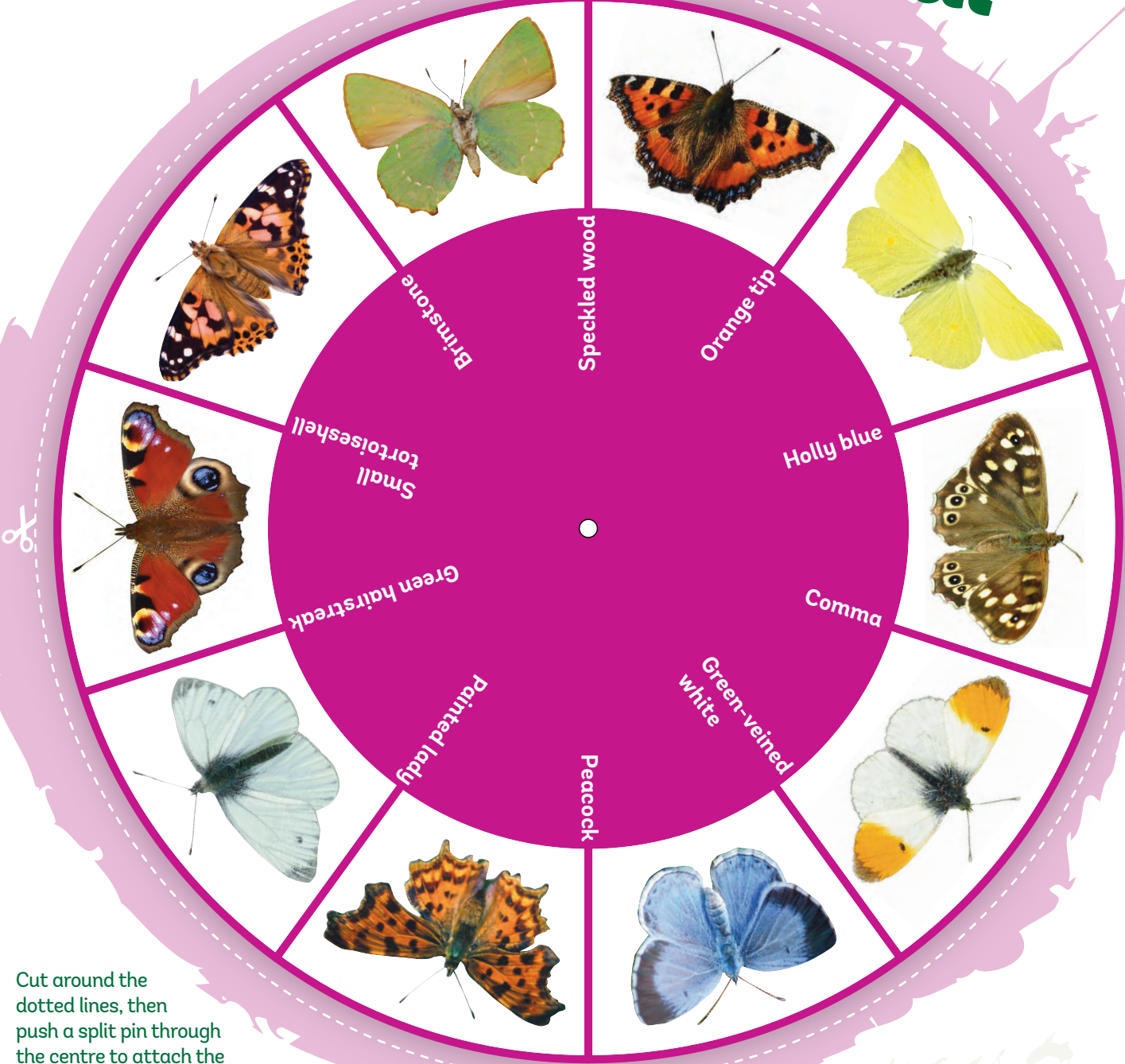

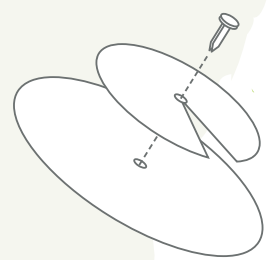
How many of these butterflies can you spot?

Fab facts!

Butterflies drink nectar using their proboscis. It's a bit like a really long tongue!

Butterfly wings are made up of tiny scales.
